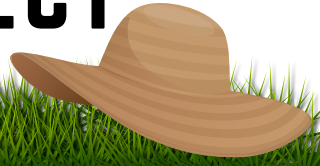

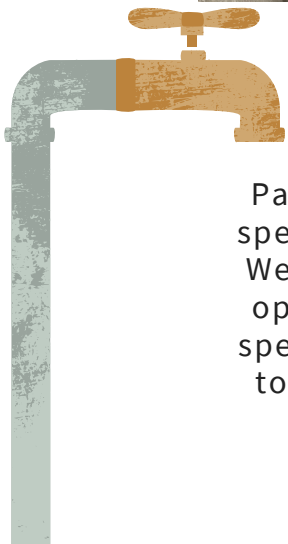
HARD AT WORK!
